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PART II - NARRATIVE SUMMARY

PERSONNEL AND ADMINISTRATION

The 1st Tank Battalion remains in administrative control of its companies which are all located in the Da Nang TAO.

The 1st Tank Battalion is currently in category C-2 with a chargeable strength of 40 Marine Officers, 500 Marine Enlisted, 2 Navy Officers, and 10 Navy Enlisted.

During the month of November:

- (a) Joined 7 Marine Officers.
- (b) Joined 37 Marine Enlisted.
- (c) Transferred 3 Marine Officers.
- (d) Transferred 100 Marine Enlisted.
- (e) Of the Marines transferred, 1 Officer and 30 Enlisted were assigned to duty with BLP 3/1 SLF BRAVO.
- (f) Eight requests for extensions of overseas tours were submitted, bringing the total man-months gained by extension to 534.

It is anticipated that the Battalion will lose 97 more Marines during the month of December due to normal rotation attrition. Replacements for most losses are not expected until January; therefore it is anticipated that by 15 December, the battalion will be in OPREP Category III.

During the month of November, this battalion sustained 5 hostile casualties, 2 of which required medical evacuation, and 4 non-hostile casualties, all of which required medical evacuation. One of the non-battle casualties was the result of an accidental discharge of a 30 cal machine gun.

Administration and personnel accounting continue without significant difficulty. It is anticipated that MOS 0141 will become critical within the next 30 days due to normal rotation of clerical personnel. Other clerical problems arise from key personnel being rotated without a contact relief. A few days lead time would be of great benefit to newly arrived clerks in order for them to adjust to their new duties.

There has been some difficulty in keeping typewriters and embossers in good working order. Repair facilities are slow, and replacements are not available while equipment is deadlined.

The Battalion had one court-martial during the month of November and 7 non-judicial punishments.

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Weather. The temperature range for November remained within the mean average for the previously experienced Novembers. The mean temperature ranged between 69 and 80. Total precipitation for the month was 8.3 inches. Although the total precipitation was 6.8 inches below the monthly average, enough rain was received to keep trafficability at a minimum.

Intelligence. During November a light section of Company "B" participated in Operation Foster; however, no major contact involving tanks occurred. The Battalion's mine incidents total rose to 109 with five mine incidents during the month. Four mine incidents involved tanks and the fifth resulted in major damage to five ton truck. Company "C" continued to bear the brunt of the mine incidents, having led the Battalion nine out of eleven months in total mine incidents. The Battalion's box score for November was 11 VC KIA (confirmed) and 54 VC KIA (probable), and 5 VC WIA.

Numerous low level agent reports and special reports were received indicating increased activity in and around the "rocket belt". Only through aggressive patrolling was the enemy denied the opportunity to establish firing positions. The Battalion and Southern Sector tenent units participated in excess of eight hundred activities during November. The Battalion continues to react to special intelligence reports with special activities and did so on three occasions with up to platoon size activities.

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~~UNCLASSIFIED~~CONFIDENTIALOPERATIONS AND TRAINING

During the month of November, the 1st Tank Battalion participated in one major operation. On 13 November, a light section from Company B, 1st Tank Battalion moved into position at APT907545 as a blocking force for Operation Foster. Throughout the operation, elements of Company B were called upon to provide direct-fire support, blocking positions and react to enemy sightings.

Company A (-) continues as security for the two top-priority bridges in the Southern Sector Defense Command AOR, the Song Cau Do Bridge and the Song Tuy Loan Bridge. One platoon of tanks is located at each bridge.

Company B (Rein) continues in direct support of the 7th Marines. Poor trafficability in the 7th Marines TAOR has limited tank operating capabilities and restricted movement to the roads.

Company C continues in direct support of the 5th Marines in the Marble Mountain area. Trafficability in the Marble Mountain area is good because of the sandy terrain.

On 26 November, the 3rd Platoon, Company C, 1st Tank Battalion was transferred to BLT 3/1, SLF BRAVO.

On 29 November, the 2nd Platoon, Company A, 3d Tank Battalion, from BLT 2/3, SLF BRAVO, entered the 1st Tank Battalion C. P. On 1 December the platoon will be redesignated the 2nd Platoon, Company A, 1st Tank Battalion.

Results of the various activities in which the 1st Tank Battalion participated during November were 11 V.C. KIA (confirmed), 54 V.C. KIA (probable) and 5 V.C. WIA.

During the month of November, the 1st Tank Battalion's M-67A2 flame tanks expended a total of 4,200 gallons of diesel fuel on assigned missions.

Anti-tank activities increased during November from the previous month. There were four mine incidents involving tanks, one mine incident involving a truck and one anti-tank rocket incident. The mined tanks received from light to moderate damage and the truck received heavy damage. The mines averaged 40 pounds in size and were pressure-detonated. There

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were a total of three USMC WIA (non-evac) resulting from the mine incidents. The rocket incident involved incoming RPG rockets. No hits were scored by the enemy and no casualties were sustained.

Training for the 1st Tank Battalion centered on weapons safety, care and cleaning of the M16 rifle and mines and booby traps.

A comprehensive battalion quarterly inspection schedule was initiated encompassing 22 functional areas with staff officers inspecting all companies.

The officer and staff NCO school continues to meet each Friday night. Subjects presented during November included supporting arms fire adjustment and control and recognition of performance of duty. A briefing summarizing the activities within the 1st Division TAOR was initiated on a permanent basis by representatives of the S-2 and S-3.

A meeting every Tuesday morning for all battalion officers was instituted in November. This meeting allows all section heads to summarize their week's activities and to inform the other sections of their plans for the coming week. All newly-arrived personnel continue to be briefed by the Battalion Commander. Officers and SNOOs are also briefed on an individual basis by the staff sections. Enlisted personnel are processed through a formal orientation program.

The Combat Operations Center of the 1st Tank Battalion continues to initiate, control and direct defensive activities within the Southern Sector. During the month 840 activities were conducted by the SSDC tenant units.

1st Tank Battalion conducted 60 patrols and ambushes and responded with 3 special activities of platoon-size in the SSDC TAOR.

Three significant events occurred in the 1st Tank Battalion during November. At 051925Z a Marine loading ammunition onto a tank was struck in the right leg by a sniper round resulting in one USMC WIA (med-evac). At 080100H two tanks from Company B were in position as a reaction force for 3/7 at (AT 920577) when they received one incoming RPG round and mortar fire. At the same time they were requested to move to assist an infantry unit which was under heavy attack. Enroute to the scene the tanks were ambushed by an estimated 30 NVA and received 3 RPG rockets and automatic weapons fire. The tanks were not hit.

On 221800H approximately 100 V.C. were spotted in the open at (AT 904666) by a 7th Marines' patrol. B-34 fired direct supporting fire and was credited with 25 V.C. KIA (probable). A secondary explosion was also obtained by the fire, indicating the possibility of a V.C. rocket or mortar team.

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As of 30 November 1967, the following 16 major end items of equipment were T / E deficiencies: M51 recovery vehicle, six M40A3 tanks, three M30A1 utility trucks, one M37 cargo truck, two M5 mixing and transfer units, one test set AN/GRM-55, one trailer mounted steam cleaner and one PU-402 30kw generator.

The Battalion Maintenance Platoon repaired three mine-damaged tanks and one mine-damaged tank is still awaiting parts. Five tanks going afloat with BMT 3/1 were prepared during November. Authority was received to retain a tank submerged during October. All tanks in both Company B and C were given LTI's. Quarterly maintenance checks were performed on 14 vehicles. The number of Xenon searchlights was reduced from 53 to 40 with the transfer of one platoon to the SLF on 26 Nov. Of the 40, 36 are operational, 6 are in 1st FSR for repair and 6 are in Battalion Supply for placement on T/E deficiency tanks. Requisition has been submitted for 5 additional lights. Three tank power packs, one TD-15 bulldozer and two M51 VTR's are at 1st FSR for repairs with no known completion date.

During November the 1st Tank Battalion requested and received assistance from the Division Engineer Officer to bury a Vietnamese trash dump located south of the battalion cantonment. The work started on 23 November with completion expected in December.

Preparations commenced for the Division Command Material Management Inspection to be conducted on 15 December under the cognizance of the G-4. Normal Battalion Quarterly Technical Inspections were advanced in order to be completed prior to 10 December.

During this month there has been continued improvement in defensive bunkers. All communication lines in the cantonment have been rewired. Navy Public Works personnel have rescreened and repaired all major buildings where necessary and rewired approximately 40% of the living quarters.

Supply response in general increased considerably during November. Some track and left tension bars for tracked vehicles were received. This command also received one M49A2C tanker, four M54A2C 5 ton trucks, 1 M109A2C shop van, electrolyte, oxygen, tires and tubes (900x20). Rainsuits were issued to all personnel as part of the overall monsoon preparation. There were 294 M16A1 rifles received and issued to all persons who carry a rifle as a T/O weapon.

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~~CONFIDENTIAL~~CONFIDENTIALCOMMUNICATION-ELECTRONICS

During the month of November the Communication Section continued to maintain communication systems organic to the battalion and the Southern Sector Defense Command.

The Wire Section completed the installation of new wire lines throughout the cantonment. This completed the setting of forty-seven poles and laying of completely new cable and lines throughout the entire camp, including new lines to all bunkers. Two new lines were obtained in the Division cable from this unit to the 7th Engineer detachment and bridge security at Cau Do. This new wire system ties in with the new switchboard that was installed last month. The average calls handled by this switchboard continues to run between 250 and 275 local calls and 225 and 250 trunk calls daily.

With the installation of two modification kits in the tanks departing on the SLF, the modification program has reached 98% completion. Quarterly maintenance service was performed on all electronic equipment scheduled for this month. An inspection of electronic equipment and records were held on Company "A" and "C" during the month with satisfactory results.

The Message Center and Radio Section continued to maintain the radio and teletype circuits organic to the Battalion and the Southern Sector Defense Command. The Message Center continues to handle all incoming and outgoing message traffic for five tenant units in the Southern Sector Defense Command.

Next month an inspection is scheduled for Company "B". Also planned is a continuing program for the maintenance and improvement of the newly installed wire system.

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CONFIDENTIALCONFIDENTIALMEDICAL

There was a significant decrease in Aid Station visits during the month of November. A total of 551 patients were seen, as compared to the usual 700-900 in previous months. Only 20 laboratory tests were performed. There were 395 immunizations given.

Eleven men were hospitalized during the month. Six for injuries and five for medical illness. Of the six injuries five were received in action with hostile forces. Three hostile action injuries were returned to duty after treatment in the field, or very brief hospital observation. Two that were hostile casualties were evacuated out of country. Three men receiving non-hostile injuries and one medical illness case were evacuated. Lost days attributable to illness in the Battalion totaled 60, a decrease from earlier months.

There was a marked increase in venereal disease within the Battalion, with sixteen new cases reported. Of these, twelve were contracted within the DaNang TAOR.

Five corpsmen were lost to the Aid Station during the month. Two received new orders and three rotated to CONUS. The Medical Section as of 30 November has an enlisted strength of ten, four below T/O. Anticipated personnel losses in the near future require replacements if desired medical coverage is to be provided.

There were no major medical projects inaugurated in November. However, a program of quarterly medical administrative inspections was instituted. H&S Company as well as two of the three gun companies were inspected and found satisfactory with minor discrepancies. All discrepancies can easily be corrected.

Med-Cap activity during November increased significantly. No action has been taken by the division on a request for construction of a medical bunker.

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~~UNCLASSIFIED~~CONFIDENTIALCIVIC ACTION

During the month of November, the First Tank Battalion was assigned the Hamlet of Phu Hoa within the Battalion's Civic Action Area of Responsibility. The Hamlet Chief and the people seem friendly and it is felt that they will be responsive to the Civic Action Program.

Two pigs at the breeding farm had litters during November. These eleven piglets will be used to start more pig farms, thereby expanding the pig project in Phong Bao.

The Rewards Program accounted for the turn-in of several items of ordnance. This program has been very successful in the Southern Sector and continues to be well publicized.

Mr. Bill Cook, the agricultural representative to Quang-Nam Province, visited the Civil Affairs Officer during November. Plans were discussed for planting hegar and milo, crops related to sorghum, on an experimental basis. These crops will eventually be used as pig feed provided they can be grown successfully.

The MEDCAP program showed a marked increase in response during the month. The total number of people assisted went over 900 for the first time in several months.

PSYOPS continued in the Southern Sector through the use of bulletin boards and leaflets. Primary emphasis was placed on the Rewards Program.

During November materials were distributed in the following quantities:

- 1 truck load of lumber to the pig farms.
- 1 truck load of lumber and 1 blackboard to Phong Bao School.
- 280 school kits.
- 600 articles of clothing.
- 115 bars of soap.

5 November 1967: At 051900H, a tank from the 2nd Platoon, Company B, located at (AT 907853) received a request from the infantry to fire at suspected VC platoon positions in the vicinity of (AT 927844). The tank fired 90mm. (Ref: S-3 Journal, 5 Nov 67, entry 10)

At 051925H sniper fire was received at a Company B tank position located at (AT 926527) resulting in 1 USMC WIA. No action was taken since the unit was unable to determine the direction from which the fire came. (Ref: S-3 Journal, 5 Nov 67, entry 11)

At 051930H, a tank from the H₂ Platoon, Company B, located at (AT 969607) observed 3 VC run into a tree line at (AT 957605). The tank fired 50 Cal machine gun fire with unknown results. (Ref: S-3 Journal, 5 Nov 67, entry 8)

At 052012H, a tank from the 2nd Platoon, Company C, detonated a mine estimated at 40 lbs. at (AT 067667), resulting in moderate damage to the vehicle. No casualties were sustained. (Ref: S-3 Journal, 5 Nov 67, entry 12)

7 November 1967: At 072115H a tank from the 2nd Platoon, Company B, located at (AT 926527) received incoming grenades and artillery fire from (AT 938525) resulting in 1 USMC WIA. The tank returned 90mm fire resulting in 5 VC KIA (probable). (Ref: S-3 Journal, 7 Nov 67, entry 5)

8 November 1967: At 080100H two tanks from the 1st Platoon, Company B received a request from the infantry to assist a CAP Unit being overrun at (AT 922565). The tanks received incoming rocket, RPG, mortar and small arms fire from the vicinity of

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(AT 925811). They observed approximately 30 NVA and fired 90mm, 50 cal. and 30 cal., resulting in 20 NVA KIA (probable). (Ref: S-3 Journal, 8 Nov 67, entry 2)

9 November 1967: LtCol V.J. GENTILE accepted command of the battalion from LtCol R.M. TAYLOR at a ceremony held at the Battalion OP. (Ref: 1st Tk Bn OpStat 139 of 9 Nov 67)

11 November 1967: At 110815H a tank from the 1st Platoon Company B hit a mine while on a road sweep at (AT 955584). The mine was estimated at 25 lbs. and caused light damage to the vehicle. There were no casualties. (Ref: S-3 Journal, 11 Nov 67, entry 6)

13 November 1967: At 132215H an infantry patrol was hit with grenades and small arms fire at (AT 963302). A Company B tank fired 90mm at the suspected enemy positions. The results are unknown. (Ref: S-3 Journal, 13 Nov 67, entry 5)

15 November 1967: At 151512H a tank from the 2nd Platoon Company B located at (AT 932537) received small arms fire from (AT 930520). The tank fired 90mm with unknown results. (Ref: S-3 Journal, 15 Nov 67, entry 5)

16 November 1967: At 161955H a Company C tank received sniper fire from (BT 076705). The tank fired 90mm and 30 cal. There was no search conducted due to darkness. (Ref: S-3 Journal, 16 Nov 67, entry 7)
