Motor Transport


- a. Participated in three Rough Riders.

1. PURPOSE. To publish a training schedule to prepare units of this command to assume the mission of providing Rough Rider security.

2. GENERAL

a. TIME. Times scheduled are subject to last minute changes due to possible changes in range scheduling and changes in training support.

b. METHODS OF INSTRUCTION

L - Lecture
D - Demonstration
A - Application

c. COMPANY COMMANDERS TIME. Time set aside at end of training day to accomplish various tasks such as:

- (1) Administration.
- (2) Critique of training accomplished.
- (3) Conferences.
- (4) Added instruction as required, etc.

The designation of Company Commanders time on the training syllabus is not intended to restrict Company Commanders' initiative. It is recognized that the above subjects along with military subjects will have to be covered as concurrent instruction.

d. CONCURRENT INSTRUCTION. In order to receive the maximum training results from the limited time allotted, Company Commanders must insure that they are prepared to present concurrent instruction during the lulls in the training program such as: at end of the day awaiting transportation, and during periods of instruction when all personnel are not active participants. Subjects to be covered should include but are not limited to the following:

- (1) Safety.
 - (a) Vehicular.
 - (b) Weapons.
- (2) Personal hygiene.
- (3) Compass instruction.
- (4) Map reading.
- (5) Current intelligence reports on incidents along National Highway #1.
- (6) NVA/VC weapons/mines.
- (7) Fire discipline.
- (8) NCO Leadership.
- (9) Care and cleaning etc.

e. UNIFORMS

- (1) U - Utilities with normal arms.
- (2) U1 - Utilities, normal arms, helmet, flak jacket, two canteens, and poncho.

f. WEAPON SAFETY. Weapons will be inspected prior to the conduct of all live fire exercises and immediately after the completion of the exercise before returning to the Battalion area. (See reference (a))

g. INCLEMENT WEATHER. Changes to the training schedule due to inclement weather will be announced by this Headquarters (S-3).

h. COMMUNICATIONS. During periods of field training, direct and positive means of communication must be maintained with this Headquarters. This Headquarters must be notified:

- (1) Prior to commencing firing.
- (2) Upon cessation of firing.
- (3) Immediately of all staff visits by personnel of other Commands and higher headquarters.

i. SAFETY. Safety is of paramount interest during this intensive training period. On no account will safety be sacrificed in order to attain added "realism".

j. EMERGENCY VEHICLE. An emergency vehicle will be present during all periods of field training in order to expedite the evacuation of injured personnel.

3. Enclosure (1) sets forth the master training syllabus.

4. Enclosure (2) sets forth the detailed schedule for the training period.

5. Enclosure (3) promulgates the advanced communication course of instruction. All personnel assigned as radio operators will attend this school.

6. Enclosure (4) lists training ammunition available for Rough Rider training. Primary instructors submit ammunition requests to this Headquarters (S-4) 24 hours prior to the scheduled period of instruction.

7. Enclosure (5) sets forth instructor assignments.

8. ACTION

a. S-3

- (1) Coordinate all requests for training aids.
- (2) Coordinate requests for training support from 2/26 and 4/12.
- (3) Coordinate requests for training areas.

b. COMPANY COMMANDERS

- (1) Insure strict compliance with instructions and scheduled training as set forth in this bulletin.
- (2) Submit all suggestions for improvement of training to this Headquarters (S-3).

9. CANCELLATION. 30 November 1967.
