PERSONNEL AND ADMINISTRATION

Present officer strength is 43 comparing favorably with an authorized manning level of 41. Enlisted strength is 592 compared to a manning level of 633. The battalion is reinforced by one medium tank platoon representing a requirement for one officer and 21 enlisted and resulting in an adjusted manning level of 42 officers and 654 enlisted. Based on the adjusted manning level, the battalion is short 62 enlisted. Additionally, there exists a critical shortage of tank crewmen. Adjusted manning level for MOS 1811 is 318. A total of 259 effective tank crewmen is the absolute minimum requirement to man the 62 TE tanks and five additional tanks which reinforce the battalion. The average number of effective tank crewmen available during August was 240. September losses through rotation will be two officers and 26 enlisted of which 14 are of MOS 1811.

The battalion joined 13 officers and 42 enlisted during August. Losses were seven officers and 94 enlisted.

Twelve requests for extension of overseas tour were forwarded during August. The extensions bring the total man-months gained through extensions since 1 January 1967 to 558. The major factor in the favorable rate of extension of overseas tour is the special 30-day leave program.

Morale is very high within the battalion. The R&R program continued to be the major factor in this regard. Increased special service activities and expanding PX facilities are contributing factors. Also, increased contact with the enemy and an increasing sense of commitment seemed to increase the morale of the troops. The troops are generally eager to be where there is contact with the enemy and are proud to serve in the battalion.

The battalion sustained 27 casualties during August. Four were KIA and 18 sustained wounds as a result of action against the enemy. Five non-hostile casualties were sustained.

Three special courts-martial were held during August, of which none resulted in a not-guilty finding.

Battalion level administration and personnel accounting continued without significant difficulty. A shortage of seven enlisted in Occupational Field 01 creates a significant loss of overall effectiveness in the administrative mission. The personnel shortage and heavy volume of work necessitates a minimum of 12 to 14 hours of work daily by administration personnel to ensure the accomplishment of the mission. September losses in Occupational Field 01 will be one and without replacement the level of accomplishment will decline. The battalion Data Deficiency percentage for July reporting was 1.1 percent. It is anticipated that the results obtained during August will reflect attainment of the less than one percent error goal set by the Commandant of the Marine Corps.

INTELLIGENCE

Weather. Temperatures during August remained within the seasonal mean high and mean low range; however, precipitation was only 2.49 inches as compared to the August monthly average of 5.4 inches.

The almost total lack of precipitation during the first half of the month caused streams in Thua Thien and Quang Tri Provinces to be three feet lower in depth than normal, while increased precipitation during the last half of the month caused them to rise considerably.

Intelligence. Third Tank Battalion units participated in five operations during August. Twenty-two major incidents were reported, of which 10 were NVA/VC initiated. The NVA/VC initiated incidents consisted of two SAF/AWF attacks, one booby trapped bomb incident, six RPG/recoilless rifle attacks, and three anti-tank minings. Third Tank Battalion was credited with 25 enemy KIA (confirmed) and 33 enemy KIA (probable).

The relative lack of NVA/VC military activity during August may be attributed both to increased NVA/VC propaganda efforts in preparation for the upcoming national elections on 3 September, and an increase in resupply activities in anticipation of the approaching monsoon season.

The 3d Tank Battalion Command Group and H-2S Company at the Gia Lai Combat Base had only one engagement with the enemy. A patrol encountered five VC, fired on them, and had their fire returned. Result of action was one VC KIA (probable).

OPERATIONS AND TRAINING

The 3d Tank Battalion was engaged in five operations during the month of August 1967.

Operation Rush - This operation was a three-day operation from 7-9 August 1967 involving the 2d Platoon, Company "C" in direct support of 2d Battalion, 4th Marine Regiment. The 2d Platoon, Company "C" moved from their positions in the Cumberland TAOR and staged at the Battalion CP. The first attempt on 6 August 1967 to reach the objective area in the vicinity of (YC 8998) was thwarted because of impassable streams. On 7 August 1967 the approach march was attempted again with engineer support and aerial reconnaissance to assist the guiding of the column and a successful route was effected. The platoon moved into the perimeter defense of 2d Battalion, 4th Marine Regiment and completed its mission by firing direct fire, H&I fires, and reinforcing the battalion in the perimeter defense. Results of direct fire were considered negligible because of the tall tree canopy (100 feet plus) through which the tanks were attempting to fire. While the operation failed to obtain a large VC kill-rate, the tanks and infantry were able to destroy several complexes and VC defensive installations on the heavily vegetated hillside. This denied the VC the opportunity to conduct operations against Phu Bai from those positions. Upon completion of the operation, the tanks covered the movement of 2/4 back to the Phu Bai TAOR. The 2d Platoon returned to Cumberland on 10 August 1967.

Operation Cumberland - This has been a continuing operation involving 2d Platoon, Company "C" in direct support of 1st Battalion, 4th Marine Regiment. This operation is highlighted by tanks performing escort duty for rough riders from the 1/4 CP (YD 731105) to the forward artillery position (YD 620095). Tanks also reinforced the perimeter defenses in both positions. Enemy contact on this operation has been frequent, consisting mostly of small ambushes against our columns, utilizing RPG-2 rockets. Tanks using reconnaissance-by-fire with canister rounds have reduced the number of ambushes. The main supply route is difficult to negotiate because of its narrow width and close-in surrounding thick jungle. The tanks also are utilized to fire H&I fires in their night defensive positions. A noted increase in mining in the Cumberland area is evident, but as yet the tanks have been unaffected.

Operation Fremont - This operation involves the 1st and 3d Platoons, Company "C" in direct support of the 4th Marine Regiment. Successful employment of a section of tanks using direct fire from Hill 51 has continued. Several smaller search and destroy operations southeast and northwest of Phong Dien were conducted utilizing the tanks in their primary mission. A heavy increase in mining is evident, resulting in one combat loss (C-12) with entire crew KIA. The enemy appears to be utilizing 250-pound bombs, or bigger, buried in excess of four feet. A line of detonation cord runs from an alloy fuze buried below the surface to the bomb or explosive charge, making detection with normal probing devices difficult.

Operation Kingfisher - This is a continuing operation around the Con Thien-Cam Lo area. Company "A", 3d Tank Battalion has had platoons in direct support of 3d Battalion, 4th Marine Regiment; 2d Battalion, 9th Marine Regiment; and 3d Battalion, 9th Marine Regiment. There have been no major operations during this period. A series of small search and destroy operations have been used by the Battalions with tanks in direct support. In the Con Thien perimeter defense, an increased requirement for indirect counter-battery fire is being met. Results are generally unknown because of the range involved and no direct observation. Damage to tanks as a result of enemy mines has increased. Most of the damage has been minor and absorbed by the suspension systems; however, with the current lack of roadwheels and track, such damage has been sufficient to deadline at least five vehicles.

Operation Kingfisher also extended to the west and southwest of Cam Lo along Route 9 to the vicinity of Ca Lu. Company "B", 3d Tank Battalion has been in direct support of 3d Battalion, 3d Marine Regiment and 1st Battalion, 9th Marine Regiment. Activity along Route 9 has been moderate with the tanks escorting rough rider convoys. Company "B" also performs a general support reinforcing mission in the Rock Pile-Payable area.

Operation Ardmore - This is a continuing operation in the Khe Sanh area. The 3d Platoon, Company "B" is in direct support of the 26th Marine Regiment in the Khe Sanh area. Mobility has been limited with the advent of early rains in this area. The tanks are utilized in the perimeter defense and fire occasional indirect and H&I fires.

Gio Linh. The 3d Platoon, Company "A" provides reinforcement for the 12th Composite Artillery Battalion. The tanks are well emplaced in hull defilade and fire daily indirect and H&I fire missions. On three occasions this month, one heavy section of tanks supported local infantry in search and destroy operations in a 1000-2000 meter radius around Gio Linh.

Of significant note in all areas of tank operations has been the increase of effectiveness by enemy mines and also an increase in enemy anti-tank attacks with RPG-2's. Command attention and emphasis is being placed on these aspects of enemy operations in an attempt to resolve or reduce their effectiveness. All companies have reported an increase in use of the Xenon light. Company "B" in particular has enjoyed some success utilizing the white light with Marine snipers in conjunction with night perimeter defense.

Flame tanks fired a total of one complete load (60 seconds). The increase in canister and .30 and .50 caliber ammunition is attributed to more reconnaissance-by-fire to counter enemy anti-tank attacks, particularly on Operation Cumberland.

The locations of the gun companies and their supported units were as follows:

Company "A" (Rein) - D/S 9th Marine Regiment (Dong Ha)

Company "B" (Rein)(-) - D/S 3d Marine Regiment (Camp Carroll)

3d Platoon, Company "B" - D/S 26th Marine Regiment (Khe Sanh)

Company "C" (Rein) - D/S 4th Marine Regiment (Phong Dien)

During August six officers and 18 enlisted men ('811's) completed the Battalion's Tank Orientation Course. Subjects consisted of familiarity with small arms, automatic weapons, tank maintenance, crew drill, and tank gunnery. Reports back from one company indicated that the graduates of this course stepped into their billets expeditiously and that a noted improvement in performance on the job was evident. This Tank Orientation Course was designed as a refresher for newly arrived '811's, and will be conducted monthly.

The Battalion Orientation Program was held for all newly arrived personnel. Officers and Staff NCO's were briefed by cognizant staff sections on an individual basis.

The semi-monthly briefings were held for the benefit of all hands, and volunteer attendance was considered excellent, reflecting personal interest in the mission of the Battalion and our general operational situation. A question-and-answer period was requested by the Marines attending and the Battalion S-2 and S-3 handled the questions. This type of briefing will continue.

Nightly briefings were held by all section heads and special briefings were held every Wednesday night to include the SNCO's.

LOGISTICS

On 31 August 1967, the command had a shortage of eight major items of equipment; five M48A3 tanks, lost in combat, one M38A1 truck, one M54 truck, and one M49C Tank Truck. Two of these items, one tank and the M54 truck are new additions during the period and are replacements for a tank destroyed during the month and a truck code-X'd for prior mine damage. Received during the month were two Lubrication and Service units to replace obsolete models and one TD-15 Tractor to fill a T/E deficiency. The tractor was received in a used condition and was dead-lined shortly after receipt for excessive oil consumption. The first shipment of Combat Vehicles Crewman Helmets for use with the new series radio equipment was received on 31 August.

Supply effort was directed toward reconciliation of outstanding requisitions. It is still noted that supply response on priority 02 requisitions is unduly slow. Aggressive follow-up action is taken; however supplies are not received as promptly as needed. The program to classify and turn in excess items continued as did the re-evaluation of requirements and cancellation of requisitions for items no longer required.

Tank Maintenance has continued to restore vehicles to operation as quickly as the parts situation permits. During the month, two of three deadlined tank dozer kits were made serviceable, with parts locally manufactured by the battalion. Motor Transport Maintenance continued to perform adequately. By 31 Aug 1967, there were 31 major end items on deadline. Fourteen were located at third echelon shops, six were awaiting parts to repair mine damage at second echelon, three lacked serviceable batteries, and the remainder were down for miscellaneous problems.

During the month, the unit 30-kilowatt generator was evacuated for rebuilding. Its loss leaves the battalion without a capability to generate its own required power. Present power is supplied by a 20-kilowatt generator borrowed from Company "C", 11th Engineer Battalion.

Construction of tropical huts by MCB-3 has continued with 74 of the 122 erected. Most huts still lack doors and steps, but are being utilized regardless. Mess hall construction has proceeded no further than site preparation although it is expected that the sub-deck plumbing and concrete deck will be completed shortly. A Division Engineer work order has been issued to provide a 3000-gallon fabric tank on a tower with the necessary pump and plumbing for use as the mess hall water supply.

During the month, battalion motor transport logged 31,362 miles of which 3257 were for other division organizations.

There were nine casualties med-evacued from the battalion during August.

Enemy inflicted damage to tracked vehicles totaled 11 incidents for the month, nine by mines and two by RPG rounds. One M48A3 (201873, C-12)

was a combat loss due to a mine. Six other M48A3 tanks and two M51 VTRs were damaged by mines. Both vehicles hit by RPGs were M48A3 tanks. The two VTRs and three M48A3's were still inoperative at month's end. All others, except the combat loss, were restored to operation.

COMMUNICATIONS-ELECTRONICS

During the month of August the Communications Platoon maintained dependable communications and improved defensive positions. In addition, the platoon's working and living areas were all moved from under canvas to tropical huts.

The Message Center is currently being rebuilt in the same building as the Communications Officer's Office. The Communications Center continued to pick up traffic from the 3d Engineer Battalion, which holds communications and crypto guard for the Gia Le Combat Base. During the month of August the Communications Center processed 433 messages.

Wire section had to repair all lines from the battalion switchboard to the battalion offices when a steam shovel working in the battalion CP cut all lines. The repair job was accomplished in approximately 30 minutes.

Battalion Supply has received approximately 256 new tank helmets which contain communication gear compatible with the new VRC-12 radios for tanks.

MEDICAL AND DENTAL

Battalion sick call has continued to show a slight increase over the previous month, a total of 410 patients having been seen during the month of August. Total immunizations for August were 300.

Venereal disease for August has shown no increase over July. A total of six cases were treated by this medical department, all of them having been contracted out-of-country by personnel on R&R leave.

As a result of availability of dental facilities in the Gia Le area, an intensified program of dental checkups has been initiated. For the month of August 64 dental appointments were made.

Because of the continuing shortage of hospital corpsmen in the battalion it has been necessary to discontinue our participation in the MEDCAP activities at Loc Son Village. It is anticipated that with completion of construction at the BAS and an increase in hospital corpsmen it will be possible to resume participation in MEDCAP.

Indoctrination and training of incoming personnel from CONUS has continued, with emphasis on adverse field conditions and the use of morphine by non-medical personnel.

CIVIL AFFAIRS

The 3d Tank Battalion Civil Affairs program slowed down due to a continuing scarcity of labor and preparations for upcoming national elections on 3 September 1967.

An effort will be made by villagers to complete the rice storage warehouse and medical dispensary prior to the monsoon season.

Furniture for Xuan Hoi Hamlet School will be built during the monsoon season.

Third Marine Division and III MAF scholarship program applications are presently being completed. Interviews and selection will be held in Loc Son Village on or about 6 September 1967.

MEDCAPs were conducted twice daily by a 3d Tank Battalion resident corpsman until 24 August when due to understaffing at the CP he was recalled. A total of 2142 patients were treated in August.

SEQUENTIAL LISTING OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

1 August 1967: From 010700H to 011140H a Company "A" tank fired 29 rounds of 90mm HE, one round of 90mm canister, and three rounds of 90mm WP (one HE round was a dud) while supporting a sweep by units from 3/4 at (YD 110650). Result of firing was three enemy KIA (confirmed).

13 August 1967: At 131615H a Company "A" tank at (YD 172677) hit an anti-tank mine resulting in light damage.

At 131930H a Company "A" tank spotted an enemy forward observer position at (YD 116673) and fired three 90mm HE rounds resulting in three enemy KIA (probable).

14 August 1967: At 141600H supporting infantry set off an anti-personnel mine at (YD 118669). Shrapnel hit one tank crewman, causing one USMC WIA (non-medevac).

16 Aug 1967: At 161500H a Company "C" VTR hit a mine at (YD 542405) incurring track and suspension damage. Two tanks towed the retriever back to the CP.

At 161830H a Company "C" tank detonated an estimated 500-pound bomb rigged as an anti-tank mine at (YD 544406). The tank was a total loss and all four crewmen were KIA.

18 August 1967: At 181300H a section of tanks from Company "C" fired at four VC spotted by the infantry at (YD 528^33). The tanks expended four 90mm HE rounds at the enemy resulting in four VC KIA (probable).

20 August 1967: At 201330H tanks from Company "C" were escorting a rough rider at (YD 645095) when one tank received one RPG round in the cupola resulting in one USMC WIA (medevac) and two USMC WIA (non-medevac).

The tanks expended 110 90mm HE rounds, 30 90mm canister rounds, 15 90mm WP rounds, and 10,000 .30 caliber rounds resulting in 20 VC KIA (confirmed) and 15 VC KIA (probable).

24 August 1967: At 242150H a patrol from H&S Company observed two enemy to the rear at (YD 840162). The patrol fired 20 rounds small arms fire. While searching the area under illumination, the front of the patrol received 10 rounds SAF from a hedgerow at (YD 840167) and they returned 75 small arms and automatic weapon rounds with inconclusive results.

25 August 1967: At 250930H a Company "C" tank was hit by an RPG-2 and a friendly 105mm artillery round resulting in minor damage to the vehicle at (YD 652096). PERSONNEL AND ADMINISTRATION

Present officer strength is 43 comparing favorably with an authorized manning level of 41. Enlisted strength is 592 compared with a manning level of 603. The battalion is reinforced by one medium tank company representing a requirement for 1 officer and 21 enlisted and resulting in an adjusted manning level of 42 officers and 654 enlisted. Based on the adjusted manning level the battalion is short 62 enlisted. Additionally, there exists a critical shortage ~~of~~ tank crewmen. Adjusted manning level for MOS 1811 is 318. A total of 259 effective tank crewmen is the absolute minimum requirement to man the 62 ME tanks and five additional tanks which reinforce the battalion. The average number of effective tank crewmen available during August was 240. September losses through rotation will be 2 officers and 26 enlisted of which 14 are of MOS 1811. ~~The/battalion/joining/13/officers/and/42/enlisted/during/~~
~~Additional/7/losses/14/officers/and/26/enlisted/~~

The battalion joined 13 officers and 42 enlisted during August. Losses were 7 officers and 94 enlisted.

Twelve requests for extension of overseas tour were forwarded during August. These extensions bring the total man-months gained through extensions since 1 January 1967 to 558. The major factor in the favorable rate of extension of overseas tour is the special 30-day leave program.

Morale is very high within the battalion. The AVR program continued to be the major factor in this regard. Increased special service activities and expanding PX facilities are contributing factors. Also, increased contact with the enemy and an increasing sense of commitment seemed to increase the morale of the troops. The troops are generally eager to be where there is contact with the enemy and are proud to serve in the battalion.

The battalion sustained 27 casualties during August. Four were KIA and 13 sustained wounds as a result of action against the enemy. Five non-hostile casualties were sustained.

Three special courts-martial were held during August, of which ~~one~~/ none resulted in a non-guilty finding.

Battalion level administration and personnel accounting continues without significant difficulty. A shortage of seven enlisted in Occupational Field O1 creates a significant loss of overall effectiveness in the administrative mission. The personnel shortage and heavy volume of work necessitates a minimum of 12 toll4 hours of work daily by administration personnel to ensure the accomplishment of the mission. September losses in Occupational Field O1 will be 1 and without replacement the level of accomplishment will decline. The battalion Data Deficiency percentage for July reporting was 1.1%. It is anticipated that the results obtained during August will reflect attainment of the less than 1% error percentage goal set by the Commandant of the Marine Corps.

INTELLIGENCE

Weather. Temperatures during August remained within the seasonal mean high and mean low range; however, precipitation was only 2.49 inches as compared to the August monthly average of 5.4 inches.

The almost total lack of precipitation during the first half of the month caused ~~some~~ streams in Thun Tien and Quang Tri Provinces to be three feet lower in depth than normal, while increased precipitation during the last half of the month ~~substantially~~ caused them to ~~not~~ rise considerably.

Intelligence. Third Tank Battalion units participated in five operations during August. Twenty-two major incidents were reported, of which 10 were NVA/VC initiated. The NVA/VC initiated incidents consisted of two SAF/AWF attacks, one booby trapped bomb incident, six RPG/recoilless rifle attacks, and three anti-tank minings. Third Tank Battalion was ~~not~~ credited with 25 enemy KIA (confirmed) and 33 enemy KIA (probable).

The relative lack of NVA/VC military activity during August may be attributed both to increased NVA/VC propaganda efforts in preparation for the upcoming national elections on 22 September, and an increase in resupply activities in anticipation of the approaching monsoon season.

The 3d Tank Battalion Command Group and H&S Company at the Gia Le Combat Base had only one engagement with the enemy. A patrol encountered five VC, fired on them, and had their fire returned. Results of action were one VC KIA (probable).

Command Chronology, S-4 Input

On 31 August 1967, the command had a shortage of eight major items of equipment; five M48A3 Tanks, lost in combat, one M38A1 Truck, one M54 truck and one M49C Tank Truck. Two of these items, one tank and the M54 Truck are new additions during the period and are for replacements for a tank destroyed during the month and a truck code-X'd for prior mine damage. Received during the month were two Lubrication and Service Units to replace obsolete models and one TD-15 Tractor to fill a T/E deficiency. The tractor was received in a used condition and was deadlined shortly after receipt for excessive oil consumption. The first shipment of Combat Vehicle Crewman Helmets for use with the new series radio equipment was received on 31 August.

Supply effort was directed toward reconciliation of outstanding requisitions. It is still noted that supply response on priority 02 requisitions is unduly slow. Aggressive follow-up is taken, however supplies are not received as promptly as needed. The program to classify and turn in excess items continues as does the re-evaluation of requirements and cancellation of requisitions for items no longer required.

Tank Maintenance has continued to restore vehicles to operation as quickly as the parts situation permits. During the month, two of three deadlined tank dozer kits were made serviceable, with parts locally manufactured by the battalion. Motor Transport Maintenance continues to perform adequately. At month's end, there were 31 major end items on deadline. Fourteen were located at 3d echelon shops, six were awaiting parts to repair mine damage at 2d echelon, three lacked serviceable batteries and the remainder were down for miscellaneous problems.

During the month, the unit 30KW generator was evacuated for rebuild. Its loss leaves the battalion without a capability to generate its own required power. Present power is supplied by a 20KW generator on loan from CCo, 11th Engineer Battalion.

Construction of tropical huts by MCB-3 has continued with 74 of the 82 erected. Most huts still lack doors and steps, but are being utilized regardless. Messhall construction has proceeded no further than site preparation although it is expected that the sub-deck plumbing and concrete deck will be completed shortly. A Division Engineer work order has been issued to provide a 3000 gal. fabric tank on a tower with the necessary pump and plumbing for use as the messhall water supply.

During the month, battalion motor transport logged 31,362 miles; of which, 3257 were for other division organizations.

There were nine casualties med-evacued from the battalion during August.

Enemy inflicted damage to tracked vehicles totalled eleven incidents for the month, nine by mines and two by RPG rounds. One M48A3 (201873, C-12) was a combat loss due to a mine. Six other M48A3's and two M51 VTR's
