NARRATIVE SUMMARY

PERSONNEL AND ADMINISTRATION

PERSONNEL—The most notable events in personnel administration involved the reconstitution of the 1st Platoon, Company A, 5th Tank Battalion. The platoon, formed on the nucleus of 4th Platoon, Company B, is composed of 1 Officer, 29 Marine edisted and one corpsman. Adcon of this unit along with the attached 2d Platoon, Company A, 5th Anti-Tank Battalion will be passed to 9th MAB on 1 January 1969. Opcon will remain with 3d Tank Battalion. The loss of the 1811's needed to form the tank platoon compounded an already severe shortage of 1811's.

Although manning level strength will not be reached, eight lieutenants in the 1800 field scheduled to arrived in early January will largely eliminate the critical shortage of officers within the battalion.

ADMINISTRATION -- The bettalion achieved a 00 unit-diary-error percentage average for the reporting period.

INTELL IGENCE

- 1. Weather. During the month of December, the mean high temperature was 84 degrees; the mean low was 68 degrees. The highest daily temperature was 87 degrees, the lowest daily temperature was 61 degrees. Rainfall for the month was 5.19 inches, slightly under the normal average for the month.
- 2. Mine and RPG Incidents. There was one mine incident during the month of December. On 7 December, 5 RPG rounds were directed at A24 with no hits. On 28 December, A34 hit an AT mine (estimated 22 lbs.), with moderate damage to the suspension system.
- 3. Indications. Enemy initiated ground action remained at a low level throughout the Division AO. Enemy action was limited to attacks by fire, small unit probes and matrialing.

The widely publisized Winter-Spring Offensive has not yet materialized. There has been a substantial increase in enemy psychological activities.

OPERATIONS AND TRAINING

1. During the month of December there were several reassignments of the Battalion assets and changes within the Division AO. The Napoleon/Saline Operation terminated on 2 December 1968. The Kentucky and Scotland II Operational Areas were modified and two new areas were initiated in the southern portions of the AO. Task Force Bravo was activated and has been assigned the modified Kentucky AO. Marshall Mountain has been assigned to the First Brigade of the Fifth Mechanized Division and the Dawson River Operation has been assigned to the 9th Marine Regiment.

An Armored Personnel Carrier platoon was activated during December. The platoon is commanded by 1st Lt. B. TISA and consists of 6 M113A1. An Indoctrination and Maintenance Training Program was held for the APC Crewmen and Maintenance personnel by the 1/5 US Army. The operational readiness of the platoon is not complete at this time due to a lack of communication equipment and armament kits.

2. OPERATIONS

Tanks and Ontos participated in one major Cordon and Scarch Operation, several small unit operations, road sweeps, provided road and bridge security and reinforced perimeter defense. Tanks also continue to provide a reaction force for the Quang Tri Combat Base Defense.

Company A (Rein) continues to be in direct support of 2/3, and is operating out of Con Trien! The Company participated in sweeps of the area surrounding Con Thein; Company A fired H&I fires nightly and reported a secondary explosion, that burned over twenty minutes, on 28 December. Working in conjunction with dusters and the infantry, the tanks also manned counter ambush positions along the MSR between Con Thein and C-3. One tank, A34, sustained moderate damage to its suspension system when it struck a mine suspected to be a 22 pound AT mine. There was one minor casualty.

Company B(-) (Rein) remains in direct support of 2/3 operating out of the Asphalt Plant. The move from Camp Carroll was completed on 10 December. Company B participated in operation LAM SON 271, a cordon and search operation of the Resettlement Village at Cam Lo. Armored patrols and sweeping of Route 9 continues to be a part of the companies daily mission, along with providing nightly security to the Cam Lo District Headquarters. Company B is also making preparations to assume an indirect fire roll from positions at the Asphalt Plant. The Third Platoon is in direct support of F/2/3 and is providing armored refoniassance potrols a direction force for the Mic Loc Area.

The 1th Platoon was in direct support of Task Force Hotol during December and conducted daily road sweeps and reaction forces from Calu.

Company C (Rein), in general support of Task
Force Bravo, continues to operate from Quang Tri
Combat Base and provided tanks for the reaction force
for the defense of the base. Reinforced by H51
and H52, two (2) platoons participated in operation
LAN SON 271 in direct support of 1/4. Two (2) tanks,
operating from Oceanview, provided direct support
to the 1st AmTrac Bn. This section conducted sweeps
of the surrounding area as well as providing
security for porimetor defense.

Company A (Rein) 3rd Anti-Tank Battalions CP remained at Quang Tri Combat Base. Two platoons were placed in general support of Task Force Bravo. One of these platoons provided security for the Cam Lo District Headquarters and the Cam La Bridge. The other two platoons remained in direct support of Task Force Hotel and operated out of Calu and Vandergrift Combat Base.

4. TRAINING


Training of 3rd Tank Battalion personnel during December centered on General Military Subjects, MCS Training, Weapons and Weapons Sefety.

6. Projects

The following projects were completed during the month:

Four concrete and timber bunkers were completed on the Battalion perimeter.

b. Movement of Company B from Camp Carroll to the Asphalt Plant (YD-170586) was completed.

c. The mess hall water tower was completed, and running water was piped into the Battalion mess.

- d. Λ 60 KV generator was installed to provide power to the unit mess hall.
- of an enlisted men's club.
- f. Three additional above ground personnel bunkers were constructed.
- g. Twonty-three truck loads of bunker materials were salveged from C-3 upon closing of that position.
- h. Rock fill was obtained for use adjacent to the unit mess hall.

7. Services

Services remained as previously reported during the month of December.

8. Maintenance

Maintenance efforts during the month of December were devoted to improving tank and ONTOS availability. An increase of 40% tank availability was realized during the reporting period. This can be attributed to the FY-68 R&E Program, spare parts received from other than Marine Corps sources, and selective interchange of required parts with evacuated FY-68 end items. No improvement was realized in ONTOS availability, as required spare/repair parts were not available.

9. Summary

The improvement in the logistics situation noted during November leveled out, and the overall logistics situation remained constant. Normal spare/repair parts remain critical items, and are an area of continuing sommand attention.

- 1. Medical Civic Action Program (MEDCAP) During December, 3 MEDCAPS were held in the Chieu Hoi Hamlet (YD354506). A total of 191 Veitnamese were treated. There were no cases requiring further medical attention at a hospital.
- 2. Psychological Operations (PSYOPS) No leaflets, loudspeakers armed propaganda teams or other PSYOPS techniques were used.

The frequency of NEDCAPS was reduced from two per week to approximately one per week because the nature of illnesses and infections has become relatively minor.

Fifty thousand plasters in AIK funds were received from G-5 and distributed to the Chieu Hoi Chief in Quang Tri for the purchase of building materials (cement and gravel) for the Chieu Hoi Center.

COMMUNICATION ELECTRONICS

Projects Completed

- a. An emergency escape tunnel was constructed for the communications/COC bunker. The tunnel is 20 feet deep. The tunnel is made of aluminum culvert material. The tunnel also serves as an air vent for better cross ventillation within the bunker.
- b. An inspection of all radio and wire equipment in the Communication Section was held and an overall grade of Satisfactory given.
- c. Activated HF (single side band) Division Command net on order of 3rd Marine Division CEO.
- d. Completion of one radio mount for the APC platoon.

The Communications Section continued to maintain effective and reliable Communications throughout the month of December.



1. Sick Call and Immunizations

a. For the month of December, 1223 patients were treated throughout the Battalion. There were 32 cases of diarrhea, a decrease of 16 over November. Upper respiratory infections increased to 96 reported cases. Dermatitis cases increased to 236, an increase of 95 over November. There were 175 routine immunizations given in December.

2. KIA, WIA, and Non-Effectives

- a. There were no KIA's sustained during December and only one minor WIA. After treatment by the Corpsman he was returned to duty.
- b. There were 195 lost duty days and 19 men admitted for treatment for the month.

3. Venereal disease

a. There were three reported cases all sustained on out of country R&R.

4. Sanitation

a. Sanitation inspections in Battalion CP and outlying areas show that sanitation of the Battalion is adequate. Improvements are being made as necessary.

5. Inspections and Personnel

- a. Medical material and monthly admin inspections of outlying units were satisfactory.
 - b. Hospital Corps strength continues to be adequate.

6. Training

a. Training of Hospital Corps personnel was conducted, with emphasis on administrative procedures and field sanitation.


