given [redacted] food from the Battalion Mess Hall. One M67A2 Flame Tank [redacted] demonstration in the southeastern portion of the Battalion Command Post area.

On 15 July 1965 one round of small arms fire was received from the southeast sector of the Battalion Command Post area. Twenty Vietnamese were treated by a medical team in the hamlet of Phong Le Bac.

On 17 July 1965 two rounds of small arms fire were received from the northeast sector of the Battalion Command Post. A male was seen running from the area however no fire was returned since the target disappeared almost instantly. Twenty-five Vietnamese received medical treatment in the hamlet of Phong Le Bac.

On 21 July 1965 one round of small arms fire was received in the southeast sector of the Battalion Command Post area. A flame tank demonstration was conducted in the southeast portion of the Command Post area. Company "B" fired three M48A3 tanks for registration from Hill 47 at (AT 975706) into sand flat area at (AT 985675).

On 22 July 1965 three rounds of small arms fire were received in the eastern sector of the Battalion's Command Post. Five men accompanied a patrol of the Second Battalion, Ninth Marines south of the Song Cau Do River. Area was found to be unsuitable for tank employment. Five M48A3 tanks fired for registration from Hill 47 (AT 975706) to sand flats (AT 985675).

On 24 July 1965 Third Marine Division Operation Order placed the Third Tank Battalion (-) in general support of the Third Marine Division. Third Tank Battalion was directed to provide one company (-) in direct support under the operational control of the Third Marines and to provide one company (-) in direct support under the operational control of the Ninth Marines. Company "A" (-) Rein. was placed in direct support operational control of the Third Marines and Company "B" (-) Rein. was placed in direct support operational control of the Ninth Marines. Company "C" (-) Rein. remained attached to the Fourth Marines in Chu Lai and the Third Platoon, Company "C" remained attached to the Third Battalion, Fourth Marines in Phu Bai.

On 25 July 1965 five men accompanied a squad patrol from the Second Battalion, Ninth Marines into hamlets in the vicinity of the Battalion Command Post. No enemy encountered.

On 26 July 1965 a twenty man reconnaissance patrol was conducted along the north bank of the Song Cau Do River, (AT 998706) to (AT 971705). No indication of enemy activity.

On 30 July 1965 a helicopter reconnaissance of the area south and southwest of Marble Mountain (BT 075710) revealed that the terrain in this area is particularly suitable for tank employment. A tank section from Second Platoon, Company "B" conducted a reconnaissance patrol with Company "D", Third Reconnaissance Battalion along the west bank of the Song Can Bien River. Approximately fifteen Vietcong were spotted running rapidly away from the tanks three thousand meters to the south of

their location at (BT 072701). Contact was not made. At 301115H July a tank from this patrol hit a land mine at (BT 069690). The right track was damaged slightly and there were no casualties. The tank was completely repaired by 301404H July. On 302122H July two tanks from the second platoon Company "B" were committed by the Commanding Officer Naval Construction Battalion - 9 to search the area north of their location (BT 065725) for sources of sniper fire. A thorough search was conducted without contact and the tanks returned to their position at 2245H.

SECRETPART IINARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. Background. During the first week in June 1965 Third Tank Battalion (-) was alerted for deployment to the Republic of Vietnam. At this time Company "A" was located at DaNang, Republic of Vietnam, attached to the Third Marine Regiment. Company "C" was located at Chu Lai, Republic of Vietnam, attached to the Fourth Marines. Third Tank Battalion Headquarters and Company "B" (-) were located at Camp Hansen, Okinawa. On 25 June 1965 Third Tank Battalion (-) consisting of Headquarters and Service Company and Company "B" (-), attached to Regimental Landing Team - Nine, departed Camp Hansen, Okinawa and embarked aboard amphibious shipping of the Seventh Fleet. Headquarters, Third Tank Battalion was located aboard the USS WASHTENAW County - LST 1166. On 3 July 1965, Battalion Headquarters and Headquarters and Service Company, Third Tank Battalion departed Naha Port, Okinawa for DaNang Port, Red Beach Two, Republic of Vietnam.

2. Mission Assigned

a. The Third Tank Battalion mission is to provide combat support for the Third Marine Division in current operations utilizing mobility, armor-protection, fire power, and shock action to close with and destroy enemy forces, fortifications and materials. The Third Tank Battalion (-) is in general support of the Third Marine Division with a tank company (-) in direct support operational control of the Third Marines, a tank company (-) in direct support operational control of the Ninth Marines, and a tank company attached to the Fourth Marines.

3. Chronological Summary of Events

On 8 July 1965 Headquarters, Third Tank Battalion debarked at Red Beach Two, DaNang Port, Republic of Vietnam and established the Command Post adjacent to Company "A" at (AT 985742). On 10 July 1965 the Command Post moved to the southern perimeter of the Division Area of Responsibility at (AT 988711). Extensive defensive positions were established in coordination with the Ninth Marines, Third Anti-Tank Battalion, and the First Amphibian Tractor Battalion.

On 11 July 1965 the Commanding General, Third Marine Division directed that a two tank section be deployed immediately to the Monkey Mountain area (BT 0284) to enhance local security and provide a direct fire capability against harbor targets identified by CTF 76.4.

On 14 July 1965 a two tank section from Company "B" was displaced from the Battalion CP to defensive positions at the northern approach of the Highway One bridge which crosses the Song Cau Do River at (AT 998708). A twenty-four man reconnaissance patrol was conducted along the northern bank of the Song Cau Do River from (AT 998708) to (AT 969699) without enemy contact. Two rounds of small arms fire were received in the Battalion's Command Post. Fire was not returned since the target could not be identified. A civic action program was started in the hamlet of Phong Le Bac (AT 983705). Fourteen Vietnamese patients were
