PART II

MARRATIVE SUMMARY

During the month of June this battalion was under the operational control of 1st Division, 27th, 7th and 26th Marine Regiments and involved in operation ALLENBROOM/MAMELUKE THRUST. During the month enemy contact varied from sporadic light sniper fire to heavy small arms, automatic weapons and mortar fire. From 17 June to 19 June 1968 the Battalion was held as Division Reserve and located at Dai La Pass, Danang, Republic of Vietnam. During June the Battalion continued to maintain two rears; one at Quang Tri Combat Base, the second at Dai La Pass, Danang.


SECULATIAL LISTING OF SIGNIFICART EVENTS

1. COMBAT MISSIONS ASSIGNED

- a. As division reserve, to counter attack and destroy enemy forces threatening vital installations and/or occupying areas within the Division TAOR.
- b. Assume defense of Dai la Pass until relieved of mission by Higher Headquarters.
 - c. Conduct search and destroy operations in support of Operation ALLABROOM.
- d. Conduct search and destroy operation in support of Operation WANTELUKE THRUST.
 - e. Conduct day and night patrols and ambushes in AO.
- f. Be prepared for employment in the Antenna Valley area under operational control of the 26th Marines to seek out and destroy enemy forces in assigned AO.

2. SIGNIFICANT OPERS SONDUCTED

- a. From 1 June until 6 June the Battalion remained under operational control of the 25th Marine Regiment and continued offensive operations in the ALLENBROOK AO. During the period 1-6 June the Battalion made contact with a large enemy force, Killing 23 NVA and capturing large amounts of enemy equipment, rice and documents. Friendly casualties were light.
- b. From 7 June until 16 June the Battalion conducted operations South and West of Hill 55 Combat and Fire Support Base in conjunction with Operation MAMELUAL THRUST. Throughout this period the Battalion was under the operational control of the 7th Marine Regiment. During the operation the Battalion destroyed numerous bunkers and cave complex's, and captured large amounts of ordnance, food, weapons and documents. Heavy contact resulted in 158 NVA KIA and one POW.
- c. From 17 June until 19 June the Battalion was placed under the operational control of the 1st Marine Division! maintaining positions at Dai La Pass, Danang RVN.
- d. On 20 June the Battalion was placed under the operational control of the 26th Marines and moved by helicopter from Dai La Pass, Danang, RVN to vicinity of 800566 to conduct operations in the Happy Valley complex. The operation will continue into the month of July. To date enemy contact has been light; characterized by sniper fire and sighting of small, isolated groups of NVA. Several large harbor sites of platoon to regimental size were uncovered and reported to 26th Marine Regiment. Friendly casualties were light.



6. COMMAND RELATIONS The 3rd Marine Division continued to exercise administrative control of the Battalion for the entire period. This Battalion's administrative rear is located at Quang Tri, RVN; with alternates located at Dai La Pass, Daning, RVN and An Hoa Combat Base, RVN. The 27th Marine Regiment exercised operational control from 1-6 June, the 7th Marine Regiment from 7-16 June, the 1st Marine Division from 17-19 June and the 26th Marine Regiment from 20-30 June 1968.

- 7. IQUIFILIT The shortage of 19 AN/PRG-25's materially effected the operational capability of this Battalion for a short time during June; causing a drop to C-3 on a special operational status report. This deficiency was corrected on a very timely basis.
- 8. LOGISTIS During the month of June the supply situation was adequate. Normal resupply was conducted by CH-46 to the Battalian in the field. However bayonets, scabbards and first aid kits were in short supply.
- 9. CIVIC ACTION During the month of June this Eattalion conducted no major civic action services, primarily because this unit operated entirely in VC/NVA controlled areas. However, numerous wegens and children were treated for wounds and disease and if necessary, evacuated.
- 10. ADMINISTRATION Company administrative rears were maintained to provide administrative services to personnel of the command. It is noted that the physical distance between the Battalion in the field and the adminstrative rear at Queng Tri has presented problems that greatly restricted the administrative services for the members of this command.



12. INTILL CENCL

a. Surmary of known enemy activity

- 1. Although large enemy unit contact continued in the ALLEMPECOK area, the enemy made no attempt to counterattack. Thus indicating a definite lack of ability to react quickly to the tactical situation. He continued to indicate his fanatical desire to hold certain positions in spite of overwhelming fire power and to die in place if ordered.
- 2. During operation AAMELUKE THRUST contact remained heavy as the Battalion uncovered numerous bunkers and cave complexes, particuarly on operations in the Happy Valley complex, many of those sites were of Regimental size and showed evidence of recent occupation. This indicated again the ability of the enery to fight at time and place of his choosing and an ability to make large unit withdrawals if the tactical situation does not present favorable conditions for sucess on the battlefield.
- b. Enemy use of Supporting Arms In the ALLENBROCK and MAGRIUKE area of operations no heavy stillery was encountered: however, the NVA made use of 60mm and 62mm mortars. Most mortar fire appeared to be unadjusted and was not on target. Furing ALLENBROCK this unit was exposed to numerous and accurate rifle grenade fire.
 - 13. INFORMATIONAL SERVICE A total of 177 individual Fleet Hometown news releases were forwarded during the most).

14. COMMUNICATIONS

- a. A high standard of radio communications prevailed throughout the month of the lio enemy jamming or deception was confirmed during the period. Frequency changes were necessary because of friedly interference; these were nade smoothly.
- b. During June 19 radios AN/PRC-25 were received on temporary loan from FMFIAC (FLC). The arrival of these radio's greatly enhanced the communication ability of this unit.
- c. Critical communications equipment presently on requisition: Seventeen (17) AN/PRC-25; Seven (7) TA-312's; Eleven (11) TA-1's; Seven (7) PSR-1's and one (1) SB-22.
- 15. WEATHER The month of June was generally clear with many afternoon and evening showers. It is noted that rice paddys have started filling thus hampering troop and heavy vechical movement in certain localities within the ALLENBROOM and MAJELUKE THRUST AO's.
- 16. FIRE SUPPORT AND FIRE SUPPORT COORDINATION During this period the Battalion was under the operational control of three Regiments. Fire support and coordination provided excellent fire and coordination.

- 17. AIR SUFFORT The Battalion was supplied in the field exclusively by CH-46's with good results. Medical evacuations were handled most expenditionsly by CH-46's and UH-34's. Close air support was utilized continuously by this Battalion. In many situations the employment of this most valuable supporting arm allowed tactical movement which otherwise may have been impossible. In several occasions artiflicity, close air support, guiships and tactical movement were used with outstanding results. On the 7th and 20th of June the entire Battalion was noved from secure base camps into offersive landing sones in a smooth, afficient manner.
- 18. MaDICAL During the month of June, 792 Marines were exam and or treated \$1000 these 10 Marines were wounded by bostile action with none requiring medical evacuation. There were 20 nonbattle injuries, 3 of which required medical evacuation. Total immunications for the month were \$13.
- 19. CHAPLAIN AND ADRALE CHAPAGE. The Esttalion chaplain conducted delly services during the menth of June until he was wounded in action. As of 30 June no replacement for the chaplain has reported to this upit.
